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## Overview

The goal of this project is to create a *What's New* page for the new LMS user interface. This page allows Portal Administrators to present custom content to their end users, including content tailored by Organization and Position Branding tools.

The Free LMS will continue to come with default Home Page HTML File content pictured below.

- [1. This page will support Impersonation.](#)
- [2. This page will work properly on Android and Apple mobile devices.](#)
- [3. This page will support user specific cultural date formatting](#)
- [4. This page will support language preferences, including: English, English – United Kingdom, English – Australian, Chinese – China, Francias – Canada, Italian – Italy, Portuguese – Brazil, Espanol – Mexico](#)
- [5. The page should be part of the new user interface code project. It should not be developed as a separate code project.](#)
- [6. The page will use the new standard user interface page template with the common header.](#)
- [7. Any new CSS stylings will be added to a global baseline stylesheet. No new stylings will be added to stylesheet.css or stylesheet-responsive.css](#)

### Default Content

The Free LMS will continue to display default *Home* page content pictured below.



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### Content Management

[The LMS Information page will be updated to include a What's New page section. The What's New page section will include a What's New Language and What's New Content fields. These fields will operate similarly to other Language field pairs. That is English must always be paired with What's New Content, but the other languages can be blank. The](#)



What's New Content field will be a drop down of the HTML content files available in the portal. These fields will default as follows:

<u>What's New Language</u>	<u>What's New Content</u>
<u>English</u>	<u>home_page</u>
<u>Espanol - Mexico</u>	<u>home_page_es-MX</u>
<u>Francias - Canada</u>	<u>home_page_fr-CA</u>
<u>Italian - Italy</u>	<u>home_page_it-IT</u>
<u>Chinese - China</u>	<u>home_page_zh-CN</u>
<u>Portuquese - Brazil</u>	<u>&lt;none&gt;</u>

Based on user language preferences the What's New page will display either the user's language specific content or the English content if there is no user language preference content.

## Update Login Landing Page

Update the Login Landing Page on the LMS Information page to include the What's New page as an option. When the Login Landing Page is set to "What's New" the What's New page will be the first page users see when they login.

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## Relabel Branding Pages

1. Update the Organization Detail Branding page so that:
  - a. "Home Page HTML File" reads "What's New Content"
  - b. "Left Navigation HTML File" reads "Left Navigation Content"
  - c. "Login Page HTML File" reads "Login Page Content"
  - d. "Registration Page HTML File" reads "Registration Page Content"
  - e. "Stylesheet File" reads "Stylesheet"
  - f. "Header Logo Image File" reads "Header Logo"
2. Update the Add/Edit Position Group page so that:
  - a. "Home Page HTML File" reads "What's New Content"

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## Order of Precedence

The What's New page will display content in the following order of precedence:

1. Position Group. If the user's current Position Group contains What's New Content display it, otherwise;



2. Organization. If the user's current organization hierarchy contains What's New Content display it, otherwise;
3. Portal. Display the portal's What's New Content.

Portal Administrators can then use the **Site Management > Edit HTML Content** tool to add, edit, or replace this content with their own training information. The *What's New* page will display "**Home Page HTML File**" content based on the following branding solutions and hierarchy:

Portal— Edit the existing "home\_page" file with new HTML content

Organization— Copy or add a new HTML file, and apply it to target channel partners via the **Organization Branding** page.

Position— Copy or add a new HTML file, and display it to users with a particular LMS Position assignment via the **Add/Edit Position Group** page.

**Organization Home Page HTML** will override →
